## IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

### Monitoring Requirements Not Met for Three Mile Water District

Our water system violated drinking water requirements over the past year. Even though these were not emergencies, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we are doing to correct these situations.

*\*We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During the last day of September 2025, we did not monitor or test the water of customers from our list of designated homes for Lead and Copper and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of their drinking water during that time. \**

#### What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

The table below lists the contaminant(s) we did not properly test for during the last year, how often we are supposed to sample for [this contaminant/these contaminants], how many samples we are supposed to take, how many samples we took, when samples should have been taken, and the date on which follow-up samples were or will be taken.

Contaminant	Required sampling frequency	Number of samples taken	When samples should have been taken	When samples were taken
Lead Copper	Ten(10) samples every Three(3) years	Ten(10)	6/1/2025 - 9/30/2025	10/2/2025 - 10/6/2025

#### What is being done?

- Samples were collected the following week as described in the last column of the table above.
- Samples were tested at an accredited lab for the listed contaminants in the first column of the table above.
- Sample results were calculated to verify we are meeting drinking water standards.
- The sample results are currently posted online at the Districts website [www.threemilewaterdistrict.com](http://www.threemilewaterdistrict.com) and results will also be listed in the upcoming Consumer Confidence Report posted to the District Website.
